Siler's Glossary

Alleluia Company & Street Crew	Our Children's choir led by Elizabeth White and Logan Newsome. They often present a program in December, and in worship services throughout the year
Angel Tree	A Christmas Collection. Names are obtained from Social Services, Requests are placed on cut-out angels that people select from a Christmas tree. Families purchase gifts to fulfill needs.
Bell Choir	The Bell Choir performs periodically throughout the year. Practices are on Wednesday nights after the Wednesday night dinners. New bell ringers are welcome, you do not have to be able to read music to participate.
Blood drives by Community Blood Bank	Community Blood Bank supports the blood needs of the local hospitals. We do several blood drives a year. All blood collected stays in the area.
Country Store	An annual event held on 1 st Saturday in November. Crafts and baked goods are donated for sale. Funds go to support the work of the Women of Siler
Crossroads	A Family-centered evening worship service presented by the Children's Ministry. All ages will enjoy.
Dumpling Classes	A class in which participants are taught the Siler Secrets of making Chicken and Dumplings. Participants pay a small fee, practice the skill and have their family join them for dinner. Generally done once a year in the fall.
Generations Conference	A conference designed to help people who are facing issues related to aging (themselves or their loved ones.) The conference includes expert speakers covering topics of relationships, health, housing, finance and legal concerns as well as a variety of resource people to help with all these issues.
Hair Ministry	Women go to Elizabethan Gardens Nursing Home to do the hair of the residents. We wash, roll and set the hair. If you can cut hair, that skill is greatly appreciated. This is done the second Saturday of each month.
Le Grande Chateau	A Youth Fund Raiser. The Youth dress up and serve a very nice meal. You will preregister and select your entrée.
Love Boxes	The women send boxes of goodies to college kids. Individuals are ask to bring items for the boxes.
Men of the Church	All men participating in Siler activities are invited to attend the Men of the Church meeting. These meeting are the second Sunday of each month at 0700. Breakfast is served and a devotional or program is presented.

Patty Baucom Scholarship	A scholarship sponsored by the women for Siler's college students. Patty was a member of Siler who was an educator and helped to start the initial scholarship. Upon her untimely death, the scholarship was renamed the Patty Baucom Scholarship.
Prayer Quilt	Members create a hand-crafted quilt which includes ties which will be tied by individuals as they pray for the quilt's recipient. Individuals with specific prayer needs request the quilts. The quilts are presented during the worship service and all members are encouraged to tie a knot on the quilt and say a prayer for the recipient. Anyone who enjoys sewing or quilting are encouraged to participate
Secret Pals	Individuals sign up to secretly befriend a college student for the coming year. You receive an information sheet to guide you as you consider sending cards, token gifts and prayers throughout the year. In May we reveal ourselves to the student as their secret pal.
Shoe Box Collection	People fill shoe boxes for distribution worldwide by Samaritan's Purse. Specific guidelines for Shoebox preparation are provided. Shoe boxes are collected in November. You may also sign up to go to the collection center to help prepare the boxes for shipping throughout the world.
Sweet Heart Supper	A Valentine's event sponsored by the Men of the Church. The Men cook their preferred dish and bring it to the dinner. The women judge the food. Prizes are awarded. All are invited. Dates are not required.
Trunk or Treat	A Fall event typically held in late October. Children dress in costumes, adults decorate their car trunks and provide goodies as the children make the circle of the parking lot. Numerous games, activities and food are included. Fun for all.
Wednesday night dinners	Typically done in Oct-November and in Jan-Feb. Meals are prepared by a professional or by a group within the church. Minimal fees are charged. No one is excluded because of financial hardship. The focus is on fellowship. Sometimes events (meetings or Bible Studies may be done following the meal)
Women of Siler	All women who participate in the life of Siler are members of the Women of Siler and are encouraged to participate in all activities of the group.
